Who are we and what do we do?

Fairtrade International is a global organization dedicated to promoting fairer trading conditions for farmers & workers in lower-income countries. With Fairtrade, farmers and workers improve their lives and have greater control over their future.

We work by establishing Fairtrade standards and certifying products that meet these standards. These standards cover various aspects, including fair wages, safe working conditions, and environmental sustainability. When consumers see the Fairtrade logo on a product, they can be assured that it was produced and traded ethically.

Given the diverse backgrounds of our staff, the DEI training is paramount. By embracing diversity and fostering intercultural competence, we strengthen our organization and enhance our ability to achieve Fairtrade International's mission, vision and strategic goals.

As part of Fairtrade International's ongoing commitment of developing as effective organization serving a complex global system, we are looking for a consultant, consultancy or organization that can provide an initial training or series of trainings to our colleagues from the central office in Bonn.

Our goal is to increase our collective awareness about DEI issues, align with our core values of accountability, respect, integrity and partnership and identify concrete steps we can make to increase diversity, equity and inclusion within the organization and while working with a range of different stakeholders.

We want to be more sensible about different perspectives, cultivate a culture of acceptance of diversity, equity and inclusion, including intercultural perspective, and integrate DEI into our daily ways of working and interpersonal behaviours.
