Revised Tea Standards for Small-scale Producer Organizations, Hired Labour and Traders

Dear partners,

During its meetings that took place on 26 March, 7 May and 30 June 2021, the Standards Committee decided on a revised versions of the Fairtrade Standard for Tea for Small-scale Producer Organizations (SPO) and for Hired Labour (HL), respectively. For details on the decision please refer to the minutes of the Standards Committee meeting available on our website <u>here</u>.

The approved changes are the result of a full standards revision as part of the monitoring and review cycle. The revised Tea Standards for SPO and HL are available in English on our website under <u>https://www.fairtrade.net/standard</u> (under Tea in <u>SPO section</u> and <u>HL section</u>). Translations into Spanish and French will follow soon.

The revised Fairtrade Standard for Tea for HL has increased its focus on worker participation in Fairtrade through the introduction of a Fairtrade Compliance Committee and has strengthened those requirements related to worker awareness on the company's commitments under Fairtrade standards; new requirements on a rights-based approach are in place for companies to act in case of risks of forced labour and gender based violence and to enhance gender equality with the introduction of a gender policy; more benefits for workers through strengthened requirements to the terms and conditions of employment amongst other changes.

The revised <u>Fairtrade Standard for Tea for SPO</u> has improved requirements on trade including purchase and sale of green leaves, retro-certification and pre-finance.

The revised standards replace the previous versions and will become applicable as of 1 April 2022. Organizations that start their certification on or after the 1 April 2022 will need to comply with all applicable requirements. For already certified producer organizations there is a transition period for some requirements as indicated in the standard.
